Run the update.exe file. To get 2 working on this system: Change the start in to the native directory. change: "C:\Program Files (x86)\Autodesk\Autocad 2016\acad.exe" to: "C:\Program Files\Autodesk\Autocad 2016\acad.exe" Make sure all system requirements are met. Choose either the 32 or 64 bit install depending on your machine and how many GB of RAM your machine has. Click install and then restart. Crèvecoeur is a residential area in the north of the Belgian capital, very close to Brussels Airport.
